

CCDCC Alcohol Policy



Serving Alcohol

- Alcohol will be served according to the requirements of the CCDCC's liquor licence and in accordance with the safety and wellbeing of patrons.
- Only RSA trained servers are permitted to serve alcohol.
- The CCDCC discourages excessive or rapid consumption of alcohol.
- Alcoholic drinks will be served in standard drink measures.
- The CCDCC liquor licence is displayed in the administration office.

Areas of Consumption

Alcohol is only to be consumed:

- In the clubroom.
- On outside concreted areas.
- In dressing rooms. (Alcohol is not to enter any AW Green Shield or Brewer Shield dressing room).
- Not on any grassed area.

Intoxicated Patrons

- Alcohol will not be served to any person who is intoxicated.
- Servers will follow procedures, provided in their training by the Liquor Licensing Commission, for dealing with and refusing alcohol to intoxicated patrons.
- Intoxicated patrons will be asked to leave the complex.
- The CCDCC encourages safe transport options.

Underage drinking:

- Alcohol will not be served to minors.
- Staff will request proof of age, where appropriate. Only photographic ID will be accepted.
- Alcohol is not to enter any Junior, AW Green Shield or Brewer Shield dressing room.

Provision of food

- The CCDCC sells food / light snacks whenever alcohol is available.
- The CCDCC provides a range of attractive, nourishing and inexpensive snacks and light meals.

Promoting the responsible use of alcohol

- The CCDCC actively demonstrates its attitude relating to the responsible use of alcohol.
- The CCDCC educates club members and supporters about the alcohol policy.
- The CCDCC supports all Cricket NSW's RMS initiatives.
